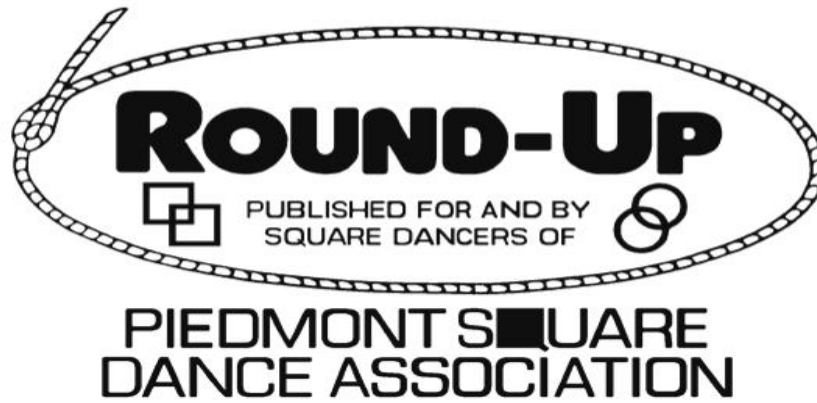

We will continue printing the paper copy of the Round-Up as long as we can afford to do so. So far we are OK financially.

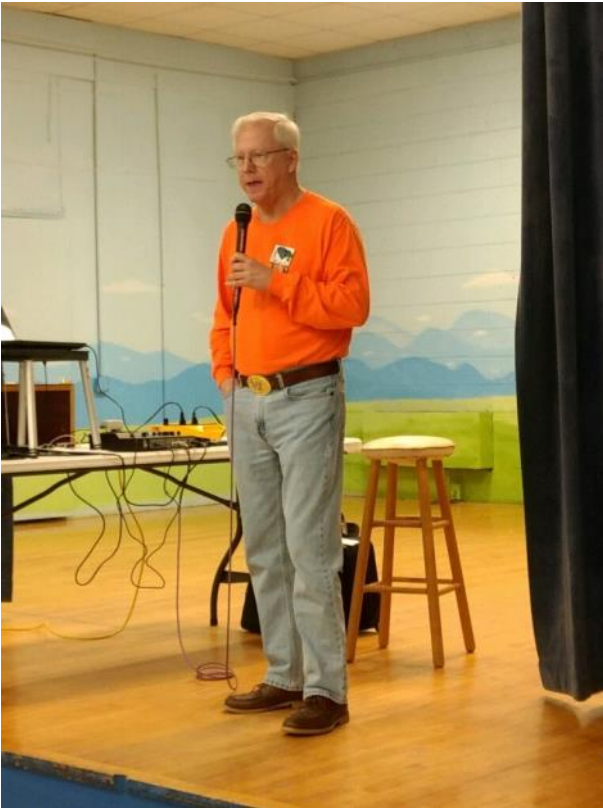

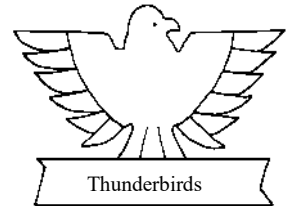
